# **What You Should Bring:**

Alaska's weather is unpredictable, so packing smart and preparing for all types of conditions is key. Be sure to bring clothes and gear that will allow you to adjust to both warm and cold temperatures.

### **Clothing:**

- Polar fleece pullover or hooded sweatshirt
- Medium weight jacket for layering
- 2-3 base layer undershirts
- 3 shirts of varying weights (easy to wear multiple times)
- 3 pairs of pants
- **Swimsuit or trunks** for the hot tub/sauna
- 1 pair of long underwear
- Socks and underwear for every day plus a couple of extras
- Gloves to protect your hands from the cold
- Waterproof day pack for carrying essentials
- Camp shoes (slip-on shoes or crocs are ideal)
- Warm hat to keep your head warm
- Baseball cap, visor, or similar for sun protection
- **Polarized sunglasses** for better visibility on the water
- **Toiletries** (don't forget your essentials)

#### **Miscellaneous:**

- **Fishing license** (including king salmon stamp if targeting king salmon): Obtain it online at ADFG Store
- **Alcoholic beverages**: Purchase them in Kodiak.
- Camera and extra memory cards for capturing the adventure
- **Battery charger(s)** for your electronics

- **Binoculars** (optional, but great for wildlife viewing)
- Garbage bags for dirty clothes and boots on the trip home
- **Ziplock bags** to keep your camera, video equipment, and other items dry

If you forget anything, there are sporting goods stores in Kodiak and even a Wal-Mart, so you'll be able to find what you need.

## **Fish Handling:**

- Rogue Charters will arrange cleaning, vacuum seal, and freeze your fish.
- At the end of your trip, your fish will be packed frozen into waxed fish boxes for your flight home or shipped depending on processing.
- If you overnight in Anchorage, most hotels have freezer space.
- If you overnight in Anchorage with out a hotel, there's a freezer in the Baggage Claim area for a reasonable price.
